1	ELECTRICAL - Inspect for damage to switch gear, wiring and/or conduit. - Check isolator is lockable in off position. - Check operation of start/stop switch. - Check emergency stop where fitted.				Y	
2	GUARDING - Check all guards are secure and function correctly (includes latches, locks, fasteners and/or interlocks if fitted).				Y	
3	FITMENT AND OPERATION - Check blade for condition, true rotation, set, cracks, deformed and/or broken teeth and resin build up, clean if necessary, recommend replacement if necessary. - Check adjustment controls for smooth operation. - Examine the fence locking and tilt mechanism for correct operation. Check for wear on threads, recommend replacement if necessary. - Check fence for correct alignment (squareness to table & parallel to blade) and adjust as required. - Check fence angle stops and adjust so the fence can be indexed for 90 and 45 cuts. - Check condition of throat pieces, recommend replacement if necessary. - Check and adjust indexing stops for 90 and 45 degrees. - Ensure riving knife is correctly adjusted and securely mounted. - Examine drive belts for flaws and correct tension, adjust if necessary and recommend replacement if required. - Lubricate all sites as required. 4	DUST EXTRACTION - Where equipment is serviced by a ducted dust extraction unit, check condition of hoods, including secure fitment, flexible connections and for obstructions. - Where equipment is serviced by a non ducted dust extraction unit maintenance covered by ME21.				Y
