2	<b>GUARDING</b> - Check all guards are present, secure and function correctly (includes latches, locks, fasteners and/or interlocks if fitted).				Y	
3	<b>FITMENT AND OPERATION</b> 1. Check and drain the moisture from the air receiver tank. 2. Check and clean air filters if required. 3. Check that the pressure release valve, guages and receiver drain tap are functioning, if necessary adjust or report if repair or replacement required. 4. Check that all hoses, fittings and connections are in good condition, recommend replacement if necessary. 5. Examine drive belts for damage & correct tension, adjust if necessary and recommend replacement if necessary. 6. Check the security of machine mountings to the floor or base block. 7.
