Check that all hoses, fittings and connections are in good condition, recommend replacement if necessary. 5. Examine drive belts for damage & correct tension, adjust if reuired and recommend replacement if necessary. 6. Check the security of machine mountings. 7. Service and lubricate the compressor as appropriate.				Y
