1	<p>MECHANICAL:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Undertake a visual inspection of the table including the paintwork, upholstery, weld points and fasteners, nuts and bolts. - Check the operation of the table - up and down function. - Check the condition of the brake pedals and operation. - Check the condition of the castors and forks and clean if required. - Check the directional steering and adjust if required. - Lubricate the pivot points, castors and side rails/arm rests/back rest (if fitted). - Check the safety catches and function of the side rails/frames (if fitted). - Adjust and eliminate any excess movement of the side rails/frames (if fitted). - Test the CPR of the back rest (if fitted). - Check the strut function and release grips of the back function (if fitted).
