2	Check the door operation, door safeties, floor levels, emergency lighting and fire services.				Y	
3	Check the pit; including safety switches, egress, lighting, buffers and for housekeeping.				Y	
4	Check counterweight, compensator ropes / chains and safety gear.				Y	
5	Check the guide shoes on the bottom of the car. Clean the equipment underneath the car.				Y	
6	Clean the top of the car, check car safeties, guarding and rooftop operation.				Y	
7	Check landing buttons, indication and gongs.				Y	
8	Check, clean and lubricate locks, guides, upthrusts, tracks and closures.				Y	
9	Check general motor room equipment including oil levels, belt tensions and brakes.				Y	
10	Grease the machine and sheaves.				Y	
11	Check controller, contacts, carbons, pigtailed, selectors, timers, overlays, terminals and wiring.				Y	
12	Check the 2:1 rope hitches, inspect the ropes and check the sheaves for wear.				Y	
13	Strip and lubricate brake solenoid, plunger, pivots and adjust to data / requirements.				Y	
14	Check connections in the counterbalances, motors, generators and the controller.				Y	
15	Record results in log book.				Y
