1	Notify the site representative that the service is being done and then set up the portable diesel fuel cleaning and polishing system.				Y	
2	Undertake a visual inspection of the tank and components, check the: a) Tank inspection ports and clean if necessary; b) Tank fittings and pipework for any leaks, damage or corrosion; and c) Tank for any leaks.				Y	
3	Check the tank fuel level to ensure it is higher than the refill level shown on the tank label. Record the level. Notify the site representative if the fuel level is lower.				Y	
4	Connect the cleaning and polishing inlet and return hoses to the tank.				Y	
5	Undertake a minimum of 3 rotations of the tank diesel fuel through the portable cleaning and polishing system.				Y	
6	Return to site 2 weeks later and take diesel fuel samples. Notify the site representative and facility manager if there are any issues with the quality of the diesel fuel.				Y	
7	Complete the test sheets and record the results in the log book.				Y
