- \* THIS TRAP SHOULD BE CHECKED, A MINIMUM OF EVERY 6 MONTHS AND COMPLETELY CLEANED OUT AND REFILLED WITH FRESH WATER TO MINIMISE ODOURS EVERY 12 MONTHS OR MORE OFTEN AS REQUIRED DEPENDING ON QUALITY AND QUANTITY OF INFLOW.
- \*\* MAXIMUM BUILD UP OF WASTE IN TRAP/TANK SHALL NOT EXCEED A 50MM LAYER OF SUSPENDED SOLIDS AND/OR 100MM OF SILT OR SOLIDS ON THE BOTTOM OF THE TRAP/TANK.
- \* WASTES REMOVED FROM THE TRAP/TANK SHALL NOT BE DISCHARGED TO THE SEWERAGE SYSTEM AND SHALL BE DISPOSED ELSEWHERE IN AN APPROVED MANNER.
- C SERVICE EVERY 6 MONTHS OR AS REQUIRED.
- D SERVICE ANNUAL
- A SERVICE FREQUENCY AND ITS INCLUSION DEPENDS ON THE SITE REQUIREMENTS.
