SPRINKLER IRRIGATION TO BE UNDERTAKEN WHEN THERE IS NO PUBLIC ACCESS TO THE SITE.  
 WATER NOT TO BE COLLECTED FROM DRIVEWAYS AND CARPARKS.  
 TANK INLET TO HAVE A LITTER TRAP AND A REMOVABLE MOSQUITO PROOF SCREEN WITH 1MM APPERTURE MESH.  
 SEEK ADVICE IF THE BACTERIOLOGICAL QUALITY OF THE WATER IS IN DOUBT OR IF MOSQUITOES ARE A PROBLEM.  
 WHERE CLEANING NECESSITATES ENTERING THE TANK, ENSURE ADEQUATE VENTILATION IS PROVIDED, AND AN ADDITIONAL PERSON IS IN ATTENDANCE.  
 REFER TO S07 FOR THE SERVICE ON THE SUMPS AND S08 FOR SERVICING THE PUMPING STATION.  
 IF WATER HAS BEEN CONTAMINATED BY A DEAD ANIMAL, REMOVE ANIMAL AND SEEK ADVICE RE CHLORINATING THE WATER.  
 C SERVICE 6 MONTHLY  
 E SERVICE FREQUENCY DEPENDS ON SITE CONDITIONS BUT AT LEAST EVERY 2-3 YEARS.
